Curt Mantz was born November 24, 1961 in Iowa City, Iowa to Russell and Betty (McGavish) Mantz. The family moved to Omaha, Nebraska when Curt was 4 years old. Betty remarried, and Curt was raised by Betty and his step-father Charles Roemig. Curt grew up in Omaha, attending Cody Elementary school, and graduating from Millard High School in 1980. As a young man, Curt was an avid sportsman, and enjoyed watching or participating in almost all sports. He also loved cars. His first job was with H&H Chevrolet as a car hop. Curt was an especially gifted driver, so much so that he was recruited as a race car driver (his parents told him, NO!). There was also the time he was able to outrun the police...

Curt married the woman he knew since grade school, Mary Plummer, on June 5, 1982 at Faith Westwood United Methodist Church in Omaha, and to this union, three children were born; Chelsea, Craig, and Marcy. The family made their home in Omaha, moved to Denver for 4 years, and returned to Omaha, where they have lived at Riverside Lakes in Waterloo since 2007.

Curt valued education and earned an Associate's degree in Non-destructive testing technology from Southeast Community College, his Bachelor's degree in Human Resources from Bellevue University, and a computer certificate from Creighton University. He put his education to good use in various ways. He worked for Martin-Marietta Aerospace Company in Denver. The family returned to Omaha, where he and Mary were family teacher's at Boys Town for 4 years. In those 4 years, they helped to change many lives, and in doing so, changed their own, as well. Curt followed his work at Boys Town as the owner of the Rent-A-Spouse handyman company, he then worked as a senior product analyst at ACI until his retirement in 2010 following his diagnosis of ALS.

Curt was very handy around the house. He loved to tinker or renovate, and could fix anything. He was also fond of working in his yard. He never watched much TV, unless it was sports, especially the Huskers or the Broncos. Curt enjoyed traveling, and took a number of memorable trips after his diagnosis, including to the Grand Tetons, South

Dakota, Florida for a space shuttle launch, and an all family trip to Hawaii. He also appreciated the beauty of nature, and took great joy in observing the eagles on the Lake near his home. He will be remembered as a man that thought of everyone else first, and put everyone else's needs before his own. He always maintained a positive attitude, and never complained. He was an inspiration to many people. More than anything though, Curt loved spending time with his friends, and cherished his family. He cherished his years with Mary, loved seeing his children grow, and start their own families, and was blessed with his 8 beautiful grandchildren.

Curt passed away at his home in Waterloo, NE after a joyful weekend surrounded by grandchildren and children having a fun sleepover and and filling him with love on January 3, 2019 at the age of 57 years, one month, and 10 days.
