Kyle Michael Niss was born September 8th, 1992 in Omaha, Nebraska to Jim Niss and Carol Cooper-Niss. He grew up both in Omaha and Elkhorn, Nebraska with his two younger brothers Erik and Justin Niss.

For primary school, he attended Laura Dodge Elementary School in Omaha, Nebraska. As a boy, Kyle was heavily involved in Cub Scouts and Boy Scouts, he enjoyed playing tee ball and baseball, he was always outdoors and loved to camp and canoe. For Middle School he attended Morton Middle School and Elkhorn Middle School where he participated in band.

He attended Elkhorn High School in Elkhorn, Nebraska and graduated in 2011. While he attended Elkhorn High School, he was a part of the Japanese Club and he played the trumpet in the marching band and concert band. He also worked at Hy-Vee during his high school years.

After graduating high school, Kyle attended Metropolitan Community College for two years where his dream was to study wildlife biology.

For most of his adolescent life, Kyle attended Camp Cedars Boy Scout Camp. After attending the camp for three years, Kyle fell in love with Camp Cedars and was employed there most every summer since the age of fourteen. He worked primarily in the nature center and climbing tower. While attending camp, he acquired the nickname "Cricket", because he could imitate a cricket. Kyle loved to enrich the lives of others by teaching them skills they would use for the rest of their lives. He became a Boy Scout after completing the entirety of Cub Scouts at the age of eleven. He was very dedicated to the Boy Scouts organization and completed his Eagle Scout Project in 2010. His project was an archery range at the 4H camp south of Gretna. Boy Scouts taught Kyle a lot of valuable lessons and outdoors skills that made him who he was.

Those who knew Kyle would describe him as selfless, intelligent, humorous, and a very loving man.

He and his wife, Michelle Niss, met in sophomore year of high school and fell in love. They dated for eight years before getting married on May 6th, 2016. They were married at

Camp Cedars in Cedar Bluffs, Nebraska among family and friends. Their marriage was a happy one and they recently adopted a dog, Sakura. Kyle worked at Rochester Armored Car Service, where he excelled in his work.

He had a love of animals and worked at PetSmart for a time. He grew up with six dogs Evinrude, Sage, Skippy, Daisy, Artemis, and Styx. He also had a gecko named Frodo. As a small boy, his first pet was Mr. Goldfish Head that he received as a 5th birthday present. As an adult, Kyle enjoyed playing videogames with friends, watching the Huskers and the Vikings, hunting and target shooting, attending anime and comic book conventions, playing Magic: The Gathering card game, and spending time with family.

Kyle died on May 3rd, 2018. He was preceded in death by his grandfather Ray Cooper; Kyle is survived by wife his Michelle; parents Jim Niss and Carol Cooper-Niss of Elkhorn; brothers Erik and friend Hannah Milenkovich of Omaha and Justin and friend Emma Will of Elkhorn; grandparents Gerda Cooper of Omaha, Lenny Niss of SD and Joyce Maschof of MN; His memory will be everlasting. He will be remembered by friends, family, coworkers, teachers, and all the people he touched in his life. He will be missed.
