Thomas Carl Green was born on June 10, 1945, in Omaha, Nebraska, to Kenneth and Helen (Kurtz) Green. He grew up in South Omaha, where he attended St. Francis Catholic grade school and graduated from Omaha Ryan Catholic High School in 1963. Tom went on to attend UNO where he was a member of the football team. As a young boy, Tom enjoyed baseball and football. He served his country as a medic in the Nebraska National Guard.

Tom married Mary Lou Mueting in 1969 at Pocohantas, Iowa. They were blessed with two sons: Thomas, II and Kenneth, and they raised their family in Omaha.

Tom worked as an accountant/bookkeeper before starting his own business, AAA Business Services in 1979 with Diana Knag. He enjoyed playing softball, golf and working crossword puzzles. He had a standing golf game on Fridays with his friends as long as his health would allow. Tom was a hardworking, personable man with a stubborn streak. He was a good storyteller, enjoyed many close, long-time friends, and was an avid Husker fan.

Tom passed away suddenly on Sunday, December 8, 2019, in Omaha, Nebraska, at the age of 74 years 5 months and 28 days. He was preceded in death by his parents Kenneth and Helen. Tom is survived by his sons Thomas, II of Omaha and his children Hannah, Daniel and Eve; and Ken (Michelle) of Vermillion, SD and his children Ben, Ava and Kate. He is also survived by his sister Barbara "Bobbie" (David) Tvrdik of Omaha.
