A. Aleta Neuhaus was born February 3, 1937 in Lloydminster, Alberta, Canada, the 3rd child of Herbert and Hildegard Brase. She was baptized on March 7th, 1937 by her father, Pastor Brase. She attended elementary school in Lloydminster through 8th grade. She then moved with her family to Omaha in 1951 where her father was called as preacher at Zion Lutheran Church. She attended Elkhorn High School and graduated in 1955. She had a job at Proctor and Gamble in Omaha between her Junior and Senior years and went to work there after graduation. On Sept 4, 1955 she was married (by her father) to Henry I. Neuhaus. She continued working until late summer of 1956. A daughter Debbie Sue was born to them on October 31, 1956. She lived with her husband and daughter on the family farm until they moved to their farm on State street in rural Elkhorn. She always had a garden and did freezing and canning, did sewing and taught Sunday School at Zion for over 10 years, was a member of Lydia Circle at Zion and later belonged to the Harmony Workers Extension club after moving to Elkhorn. Henry did a lot of traveling in the auction business and she would often accompany him. Aleta was preceded in death by husband Henry Neuhaus, her parents Hildegard and Herbert Brase, sister Cordelia Brase, sister Delilah (and Buck) Burkhartzmeyer, and sister-in-law Darlene Doll (Ivan). She is survived by daughter Debbie Nelson, grandchildren Ryan Palmer (Christy), Betsy Peter (Jason), Nikki Braddock (Dan), great-grandchildren Makenzie, Mirabel, Avery, Ivan, Gage, Brylie and Barrett; her sisters Vera May William (Ted passed) in Lloydminster, Alberta
