Aimee Wolf, beloved mother, sister, and friend, passed away peacefully on December 8, 2024, at the age of 55. Aimee was a devoted mother to her daughter, Maya (25), and her son, Karl (29), whose lives she filled with love, guidance, and unwavering support.

Born in 1969, Aimee was one of nine children, growing up in a lively, close-knit family that shaped her compassionate and caring nature. These qualities carried over into her professional life, where she made lasting impacts on everyone she worked with.

Aimee spent 20 years working as a nanny, 15 of which for the Bergman family in Chicago. Her nurturing spirit and kindness created a loving home for the children she cared for. She later worked for the past decade as an Operations Support Supervisor at Omni Hotels, bringing organization and efficiency to her role with a quiet yet dedicated approach.

her family and friends.

Her legacy lives on through her children, Maya and Karl, along with the many people whose lives she touched with kindness, empathy, and a deep sense of connection. Maya, an avid reader who loves to knit and cook just like her mom, is currently working towards her JD at the University of Minnesota Law School in Minneapolis, Minnesota. Karl lives in Brooklyn, New York with his corgi Asami and works as a Senior Software Engineer at Yahoo.

Aimee is survived by her children, Maya and Karl; her eight siblings; and numerous nieces, nephews, and extended family members who will forever cherish her memory.
