Audrey Della Williams was born on June 13, 1949 in Omaha, NE to Delmar and Virginia (Swirczek) Prinz. She grew up on a farm south of Yutan and graduated from Yutan High School in 1967.

Audrey lived in Yutan for most of her life, where she raised her sons, Bill and David. On November 12, 2011 she married Robert Williams and together they lived in Bellevue and later Omaha. Audrey worked as a real estate agent from the early 80's until her retirement in 2013. For 10 years, she owned her own business, Nebraska Realty.
