Betty Joan (Glasshoff) Lamprecht was born on July 18, 1932, on the family farm near Millard, Nebraska to William and Minnie Glasshoff. She attended Willowdale Country School (168th & Q) through the 8th grade. As a young girl she loved to draw. She was baptized and confirmed the same day in 1947 at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Millard, Nebraska. She graduated from Millard High School in 1950, as salutatorian of her class. After graduation, she worked at the ASC office in Elkhorn, Nebraska. She married Mylan Lawrence Lamprecht of Waterloo, Nebraska on September 22, 1951, at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Millard. After they were married their home has always been on a farm just outside of Waterloo. She then worked at Mutual of Omaha in the accounting department. They welcomed a son, Byron Lee on November 25, 1952, a daughter, Linda JoAnn on June 24, 1954 and another son, John Michael on March 23, 1960.

Betty was a lifelong farmer's wife, fixing four meals a day (sometimes taking lunch to the field), washing the milk buckets every day and the cooler every other day on the 'Grade A' Dairy farm and running for equipment parts. She fed chickens, sold eggs and sweet corn. She was a member of the Happy Hour Bunco Club. In 2000, she and Mylan built a new home a mile and a half

west of the home place. In 2001, she and Mylan celebrated their golden wedding anniversary with a family dinner. They were married for 59 years when Mylan passed away April 3, 2010. Betty enjoyed polka music, bowling, playing cards – Schafkopf (sheepshead), Pinochle and Shanghi Rummy, gardening vegetables and flowers, and she loved licorice. She made the best roast, potatoes and carrots, liver and onions, chicken salad sandwiches and angel food cake.

Betty passed away on Tuesday, April 3, 2018 at Nye Legacy, in Fremont, NE. Betty is survived by her son Byron (Jennie) Lamprecht of Waterloo, daughter Linda Haines of Omaha and son John (Sissy) Lamprecht of Waterloo. She has seven grandchildren — Lisa, Jamie, Laurie, Justin, John, Jr., Lindsay and Brooke and four great-grandchildren — Addison, Payden, Ainsleigh and John Riley. She is also survived by sister-in-law Irma Lamprecht and brother-in-law and wife, LaVerne and Donna Lamprecht.
