Bev worked for Western Electric and Control Data before becoming a full-time home maker. She was a 10 year volunteer for the Make-A-Wish Foundation and served on their Board of Directors for 8 of those years. More recently, Bev devoted much of her time to the Small Munsterlander Club of North America, serving as the club's Vice President for 4 years and the President for 9 years. Bev loved to make anything that came from the heart, whether it was crocheting, hand stitching sheets and pillow cases, making blankets or quilting. She was especially proud of the quilt that she made for Camp CoHoLo that was displayed across the country. She enjoyed the outdoors, whether it was camping with Randy, working their dogs in the field, or fishing with her grandchildren. Even though she was a Nebraska Volleyball fan, she was happiest when she was watching her grandchildren's sports, activities and school performances. Her favorite pastime was bragging about Kiley and Luke. Nothing brought her more joy than her two grandchildren. Bev passed away suddenly at her home in Yutan on May 13, 2011, at the age of 58 years, 10 months and 26 days. She was preceded in death by her father, Robert, and two brothers. Bev is survived by her husband, Randy; daughter and son-in-law Kathy and Chad Tremel of Omaha; 2 grandchildren, Kiley and Luke; mother Kathleen Herdman and sister Debbie Mausbach, both of Papillion, NE; and many nieces and nephews.
