“ I’m so sorry for your loss, Pritchett family. I have many great memories from the time Blaine served as our pastor in my hometown, Albion. I was in middle school at the time and Blaine would come to my softball games in the summer, as he would come to any important event in the church member’s lives. I hit a home run & I swear he was the loudest person in the crowd, cheering me on and boasting about it after. As someone who is not athletic at all it was so meaningful to me to have him so excited for me. Another memory I have is his patience with me when I became the church’s pianist at 14 years old when my grandmother became too sick. He never complained about my slow learning, mess ups, or poor timing with the hymns. His patience helped me become the best pianist I could be. I now play piano for a much larger Baptist congregation - I don’t think I’d have the confidence to do so if he hadn’t been so forgiving of my mess ups learning early on. One song we sang, Our God Reigns, I’ll always have his voice burned into my head. He would raise his hands and yell “HE IS ALIVE” and encourage the congregation to do the same and engage with the song. I’ll never be able to sing or play that without smiling and remembering his enthusiasm. My last memory is when he did the services at both my grandparents funerals, which he provided amazing and meaningful sermons for due to his time spent getting to know them and genuinely caring about them.
