She enjoyed playing Canasta with her girlfriends as well as Pitch and Rummy when family came over. She was an avid bowler for many years and threw Fourth of July parties that are still talked about. Carol and her best friend of over 50 years, Shelia Copeland, were on the phone so much, we often joke the phone needed to be surgically removed from her ear. Just kidding, but you get the idea.

Carol passed away Wednesday, July 20, 2022 after of several recent illnesses and hospitalizations. She was made comfortable with the wonderful assistance from the staff at Waterford Assisted Living and Suncrest Hospice.

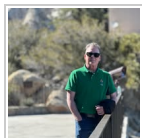
