Carolyn Joyce (Prindle) Martel was born November 4, 1941 in Jameson Missouri to Herman Thomas and Pearl Irene Prindle. She was the second of five children with three brothers and one sister. She attended school in Jameson Missouri where she excelled as the designated free throw shooter for the basketball team and graduated in 1959.

On December 6, 1963 she married Ronald Glen Martel in Little Rock Arkansas. Carolyn worked at an insurance agency for five years before becoming a mother. They went on to have three children of their own and were blessed with three grandchildren. Carolyn enjoyed gardening, reading, watching game shows and in later years became an avid bird watcher with several feeders outside her window. Carolyn was meant to be a grandmother, spending a decade watching her granddaughter daily. Whether she was teaching her granddaughter how to sew or bake cookies or being the number one fan at the sporting event, she put 100% into everything she did. She spent hours watching her grandsons play ball on her iPad, often cheering them on out loud from her chair when she thought no one was around. She dedicated her life to God and her family and had a wonderful church family who provided love and support to her and the family.

Carolyn passed away peacefully at home surrounded by family on August 23, 2024. She is preceded in death by her husband of 52 years Ronald Martel,
