



Carsten Frederick Kuehl

August 19, 1924 - August 31, 2008

Carsten Frederick Kuehl was born on August 19, 1924 in Omaha, Nebraska to Carsten and Pauline (Willms) Kuehl. He grew up on the family farm at 132nd and Dodge St. where he attended District #25 Country School and graduated from Elkhorn High School in 1941 before attending the University of Nebraska for two years. As a young boy, Fred spent much of his time helping on the family farm and milking cows but in his free time he enjoyed baseball and basketball. He was active in the Rawhide Riders and rode his pony along Dodge Street to school.

Fred married Pauline Glandt on September 6, 1945 at St. John's Lutheran Church in Bennington, Nebraska and to this union four children were born: John, Jim, Paul and Patty. Fred and Pauline raised their family on the farm at 204th and "Q" St. before they moved to 184th and Q in 1982.

Fred was a life long farmer and cattle feeder. He was active in the Millard Rural Fire Board, St. Paul's Lutheran Church Council, School Board, FFA, Mt. Auburn Cemetery Board and enjoyed his volunteer work driving the bus for the Good Samaritan Home. Fred enjoyed bowling, playing cards, Nebraska football and keeping a close eye on the markets. He loved to drive and travel but was happiest when he could gather his family and friends together for a picnic at the farm.

Fred passed away on Sunday, August 31, 2008 at the Brookstone Meadows in Omaha, Nebraska at the age of 84 years and 12 days. He was preceded in death by his parents Carsten and Pauline and sisters Peggy Fulton and Ruth Bay. Fred is survived by wife Pauline; sons and daughters-in-law John and Sue of Omaha, Jim and Linda of Omaha and Paul and Marilyn of Elkhorn; daughter Patty Kuehl of Omaha; grandchildren Jason and Lisa Kuehl, Carly and Terry Walker, Brittney and Scott Long, and Chad, Andrew, Allison and Eric Kuehl; great grandchildren Bryson, Joel and Johnna Kuehl and Carsten Walker; Sister Esther Karloff of Omaha; sister-in-law Audrey Hansen of Omaha; brother-in-law Stanley Glandt of Omaha.
