She and Jack enjoyed traveling, especially cruises and over the road in their camper; they liked to play cards and they danced the night away many times at the Starlight Ballroom. Catherine enjoyed camping if she could get Jack to stay away from home long enough to get unpacked. Catherine was a compassionate, nurturing woman who loved all children, especially her grandchildren.

Outside the home, Catherine belonged to the Waterloo Presbyterian Ladies Aid for 20 years, and she enjoyed meeting with a Bonco Club once a month.

Catherine passed away on Wednesday, January 20, 2010 at the Life Care Center of Elkhorn at the age of 92 years, 8 months and 18 days.
