A woman that fought a disease for years upon years so that she didn't have to leave the ones she loved behind, shielding them from knowing her suffering. A woman who gave so much to this world and was so loved in return. Cathi touched many hearts and the loss will forever ache. She was never afraid of death, though she had a strong passion for life. Her spirituality was what always helped get her through the tough times. Without a sliver of a doubt, Cathi is

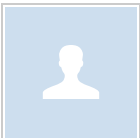

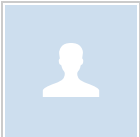

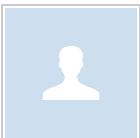
