Charles Edwin Carder was born on August 8, 1944 in Omaha, Nebraska to Clarence and Mona (Thomas) Carder. He grew up in the Benson area where he attended Rosehill grade school, Monroe Junior High and graduated from Benson High School in 1963. As a young boy, Chuck enjoyed art work, baseball and football. Chuck joined the United States Marine Corp in 19— and served his country in Vietnam. He saw a great deal of combat during his tour and received a purple heart and a bronze star.

Upon returning to civilian life, Chuck had to deal with the realities of the war that he had witnessed. He spent a great deal of time travelling the country. Chuck loved animals and enjoyed family gathering, often travelling to Atlanta to see his sisters.

Chuck passed away on Monday, March 15, 2010 at the VA Hospital in Omaha, Nebraska at the age of 65 years, 7 months and 7 days. He was preceded in death by his parents Clarence and Mona. Chuck is survived by his brother Tom (Sandy) of Fremont, NE; sisters Rosanne (Jim) Hall of Atlanta, GA and Connie Cole of Atlanta, GA; nieces and nephews.
