Charles T. Hays was born on November 25, 1918 at his parents farm in Memphis, Missouri to Virgil and Mary Ethel (Krewson) Hays. He attended numerous elementary schools and graduated from Memphis High School in 1937.

Charlie married Minnie Head on March 15, 1942 and to this union 3 children were born: Richard (Dick), Robert (Bob) and Connie.

Charlie worked at a grocery store and then he worked for Leetch Hatchery in Memphis, Missouri and Lima, Ohio. The family lived in Lima, Ohio for 2 ½ years before moving to Nebraska. Charlie managed Bayse Poultry Farm in Two Rivers before going to Baldwin Laboratories in Elkhorn and then he worked at Dellen Laboratories in Omaha. He served on the Waterloo School Board for a number of years. After retirement, Charlie worked parttime at Merchant of Venice, at the dryers and at the fairgrounds. He enjoyed gardening, his grandchildren and great grandchildren.

Charlie was dedicated to his family and cherished the time the they could all be together.
