



Clarice Marie Barnhill

February 15, 1932 - October 9, 2022

Clarice Marie (Sibert) Barnhill was born February 15, 1932 in Scribner, Nebraska to Floyd and Amanda (Hofeldt) Sibert. She attended grade school at Country School District #14; graduated from Elkhorn High School in 1949, and began working at Valley Manufacturing Company, now known as Valmont Industries, Inc.

She was baptized at Bethany Lutheran Church in Elkhorn on March 26, 1944, and confirmed at Bethany Lutheran Church on April 14, 1946. On October 13, 1956, she married Frederick O. "Barney" Barnhill at Bethany Lutheran Church in Elkhorn. They lived in Valley for 24 years and moved to Elkhorn in 1980. She worked at Valmont Industries, Inc. as an Executive Secretary for 62 years and retired in 2012.

She was a member of Bethany Lutheran Church and the American Legion Auxiliary Post #58 in Valley. Clarice's primary interests were cooking and baking. She loved to host the family holiday dinners.

Clarice passed away Sunday, October 9, 2022 at Elkridge Assisted Living surrounded by her loved ones at the age of 90 years, 7 months, and 22 days.

She was preceded in death by her parents Floyd & Amanda Sibert and 4 brothers; Vance, Harlan, Stanley and Gary Sibert. She is survived by her husband Frederick "Barney" Barnhill, sisters-in-law Sonia Sibert of Omaha and Maxine Barnhill of Fremont, NE, brother-in-law Charles Carlson of Fremont, NE, and many nieces and nephews.
