



Clem Joseph Bruning

May 5, 1941 - March 5, 2024

Clem Joseph Bruning was born in Omaha, Nebraska on May 5, 1941 to Ralph and Frances (Wangler) Bruning. He grew up on a farm between Elkhorn and Bennington. In 1959 he graduated from Elkhorn High School. After graduating, Clem began farm work until December of 1963 when he joined the United States Army. He served during the Vietnam war and was honorably discharged in September of 1965.

After his time in the military, Clem began working as a truck driver. Clem was united in marriage to Donna Dinesen on June 24, 1967 and they settled just up the hill from the Bruning family farm. Shortly after their union, Clem began his own business, Bruning Trucking Co. They ran the business together, with Donna assisting with the bookkeeping. Clem and Donna also worked together in their garden, growing both vegetables and flowers. It was a yearly family event to “Put Up Corn” for the winter months.

Clem was a big fan of country music and found great enjoyment in sitting on his front porch and “listening to the corn grow.” He was very skilled in mechanical work and did a lot of his own repair work on his trucks. He also built and flew remote controlled model airplanes and had his private pilots license and was able to fly small planes. Clem will be remembered and loved in the hearts of his family and friends.

Clem was preceded in death by his parents, Ralph and Frances (Wangler) Bruning; wife, Donna Bruning; sister, Jean Bruning; brother, Bernard Bruning; sister-in-law, Debbie Bruning; and brother-in-law, Carlson Harvey. He is survived by his siblings: Elizabeth Harvey, Gerald (Sandy) Bruning, Fred (Dee) Bruning, Janet Bruning, Don (Mila) Bruning; brother-in-law, Richard Dinesen; sister-in-law, Mary Ann (Bill) Buckingham; and many nieces and nephews.
