Curtis "Squirt" Garth Shaw was born on April 8, 1959 in Ogden, Utah to Garth and Yvonne (Kent) Shaw. He attended grade school in Long Beach, California and graduated from Bingham High School in South Jordan, Utah in 1977. As a young boy, Squirt enjoyed hunting, gardening and raising rabbits. While attending high school he was an avid bull rider. Squirt enlisted in the United States Army in October of 1979 and served until November of 1982. He spent part of this time deployed in Germany.

Squirt married Cindy on November 6, 1999 at St. John's Lutheran Church in Yutan, Nebraska. He has lived in Nevada, Florida and Utah before settling in Nebraska.

Squirt was a mechanic all of his life and recently worked for R & G Service Center in Omaha. He enjoyed riding his motorcycle, NASCAR, his affiliation with AVMC and spoiling his princess bride and grandchildren. Squirt was a generous, loving, dependable man with a perverted sense of humor. He was an avid Pittsburgh Steeler fan and loved hot, spicy food, especially peppers the hotter the better, Lord Calvert/water and barbequing on his grill. Squirt expected honesty from everyone and felt that clothing should be optional. Squirt was quite fond of his little sayings such as "Let's get nakey"; "It's all good"; and "Don't let that alligator mouth override that canary ass".
