Curtis Dean Vick was born on June 5, 1949 in Brookings, South Dakota to Boyd and Lucille (Larson) Vick. Curt went on to graduate from Augustana College in Sioux Falls, South Dakota with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Administration. As a young boy, Curt spent a great deal of time working on the family farm but in his free time, he enjoyed basketball and 4-H projects.

Curt married Linda Lee on June 3, 1972 at Eastside Lutheran Church in Sioux Falls, South Dakota and they were blessed with two daughters, Katie and Kristin. Curt and Linda raised their family in Eau Claire, Wisconsin, St. Cloud, Minnesota and Sioux City, Iowa before moving to Omaha in 2002.

Curt began his career history as a store manager for Elmen Rent-All in Sioux Falls, SD in 1971 and in 1977 he accepted a sales position for Dakon Industries, which brought him to Eau Claire, WI and St. Cloud, MN.
