Dan was born in Pueblo, Colorado on November 27, 1946. He graduated from Montrose High School in 1964 and from the University of Colorado in 1970 with a degree in Aerospace Engineering. He enlisted in the Air Force and later went to Officers Training and then became a navigator. He served as a 'second seater' on several planes, culminating with the SR-71 "Blackbird". He retired in 1990.

Dan received a law degree from Creighton College in Omaha and practiced patent law for several years. Dan enjoyed golf and music including playing guitar and keyboard.

He is survived by his mother Virginia Greenwood, his sister Jan Daoust, his son Richard Emery Greenwood, his nephew Barry Greenwood, and his great nephews Gabriel and Joshua Greenwood.
