David Jon Weidauer, age 74 of Elkhorn, died on Friday, November 23, 2018 at his home in Elkhorn. He was born the son of Oscar and Joan (Evers) Weidauer on May 1, 1944 in Muskogee, OK. He later would attend and graduate from Wayne State College with a Degree in Social Science. David served his country during the Viet Nam War with United States Army from July of 1969 until his honorable discharge in July of 1971

David was an Earth Science Teacher at Elkhorn Middle School for over 30 years. He was also an avid Creighton Basketball Fan, and loved spending time with his two grandchildren and making saw dust. He enjoyed growing his many gardens for his family to enjoy.
