Dawn Frazer, age 59 of Omaha, died at her home on Sunday, May 30, 2021. She was born the daughter of LeDon and Carol (Morris) Frazer on April 26, 1962, the second of a set of two in Omaha, NE. Dawn graduated from Burke High School and later Doane College in Crete, NE.

Dawn worked as a rehab trainer for Quality Living, Inc. She excelled in her position there because of a traumatic brain injury at 19. Her most recent position was with Walmart and was one that put her in continuous contact with the “Walmart” shoppers. She quickly became their “Go To” cashier because of her outgoing, caring and friendly nature and efficiency. For months after she left Walmart, due to her health, customers would ask, “Where is Dawn, and when is she coming back? We miss her.”

As her family we are especially blessed to have her light in our lives. Due to the depth of her emotions, she could laugh through her tears or cry through laughter. Two of Dawn’s favorite and frequent exclamations were, “I am THE luckiest person in the world” or “My favorite person in the whole world is my brother.” – However, as her family, we are the lucky ones.
