Delmar Wesley Morgan was born on December 22, 1928 in Astabula, Ohio to Donald and Gladys (Faylor) Morgan. He grew up in Ohio and after graduating from Jefferson High School, Del went on to attend Bowling Green State University, graduating in 1952. While at Bowling Green, Del was active in the Kappa Sigma Fraternity, serving as president for two years. As a young boy, Del had an interest in farming. Del served his country in the United States Army from 1946 to 1948.

Del married Patricia Newman on November 28, 1953 in Wichita, Kansas and they were blessed with two sons: Jeffrey and Matthew. Del and Pat have made their home in North Carolina, New Jersey, Tennessee, Nebraska and Kansas before settling in Elkhorn in 1992.

Del spent most of his life in sales, working for Owens-Illinois, Inc for 31 years, W. I. Lang Sales for 5 years and Morgan Machinery Company until he retired. He was a devoted member of St. Augustine of Canterbury Episcopal Church in Elkhorn as well as engaged in many civic activities with the Jaycees, Lions,

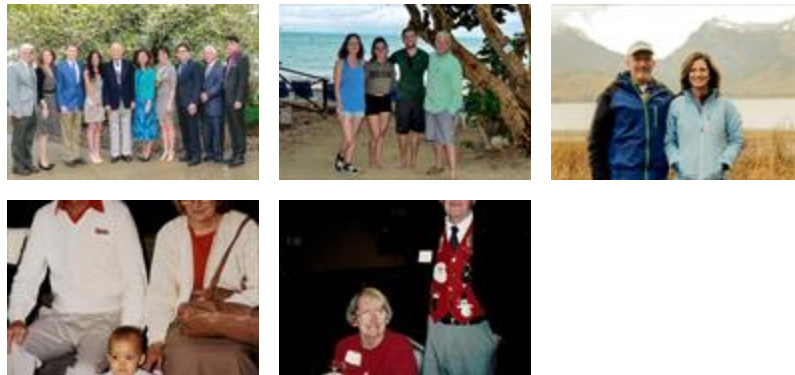
