LeDon “Don” Frazer was born on November 9, 1935 in York, Nebraska to John and Estella (Baass) Frazer. Don grew up in York, NE and graduated from York High School in 1953. In high school, he played basketball and ran track, and he was also a part of the track team at Doane College. Don joined the Delta Kappa Pi Fraternity and graduated with a Bachelor’s degree in mathematics.

While at Doane, he met Carol Morris, whom he “really, really liked”. The feeling was mutual and they were married on June 29, 1958 at Trinity Methodist Church in Grand Island, NE. From 1958 to 1960, Don served in the United States Army and was honorably discharged. After his service, Don taught math for a few years and then began working at NCR Corp, where he stayed for 32 years until his retirement.

Don and Carol raised their twins, Steven and Dawn in the Omaha area. In his free time, Don enjoyed watching sports, playing golf, and hunting upland game. Don was familiar with every subject you could bring up, which made him easy to talk to. He was a mentor to many and would offer knowledgeable and direct advice. His family meant everything to him, and he was very loyal and committed to them.

Don was preceded in death by his parents, John and Estella Frazer; daughter,

Dawn Frazer; sister, Alicia Knee; and brother, Bill Frazer. He is survived by his wife of nearly 68 years, Carol Frazer; son, Steven Frazer; sisters-in-law, Lee Morris and Jean Frazer; and several nieces and nephews.
