Don Thimjon, age 82, of Omaha, Nebraska, passed away on January 13, 2026. Don was born on July 16, 1943, to Walter and Edith (Leshovski) Thimjon. He grew up in Breckenridge, Minnesota, where he developed the values, determination, and warmth that would define his entire life.

Don attended grade school in Foxhome and graduated from Breckenridge High School in 1961. He went on to graduate from the State School of Science as an electrician. He later earned his degree in Human Resources from Bellevue University, setting the stage for a successful and respected professional career.

Don and his family made their home in Omaha, Nebraska, where he built lasting friendships and enjoyed an active, fulfilling life. Don and Vicki also spent 16 years in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. He continued to build his career,

retiring as Vice President of Utility Sales at Wesco, an accomplishment he was very proud of.

Known for his passion for golf, motorcycles, and fast cars, Don approached everything with enthusiasm and a competitive spirit. He was a proud member of both the Players Club and Anthem Country Club. Don created countless memories with those he loved including camping trips, ATV riding in South Dakota, and vacations to Hilton Head and Disney World. He also enjoyed playing golf, winning the Duel in the Desert with Todd, and horseback riding with Mickee.

Don was determined, faithful, generous, competitive, and outgoing. He loved Christian and country music, Top Gun, chocolate malts, Coca-Cola, and cheering for the Pittsburgh Steelers. He was particularly known for initiating conversations with complete strangers. Above all, Don was a faithful husband, father, family man, and servant of God. He lived with unwavering commitment to the people he loved and the values he believed in.
