Donald Hudson Miller was born on March 30, 1961 in Lincoln, Nebraska to Donald and Norma (Hudson) Miller. Don attended the University of North Dakota and received his Bachelor's Degree in Business in 1983. He was an exceptional athlete and participated in multiple sports. Don attended college on a football scholarship and following graduation, he was invited to several NFL training camps and was a member of several practice squads. Throughout Don's childhood and his adult life, family was the main focus. From his siblings in his early years to his children in his later years, Don's greatest joy came from family.
