



## Dorothy Elizabeth Bayly

July 8, 1921 - March 26, 2010

Dorothy E. (Schuett) Bayly was born July 8, 1921 in Bloomfield, Nebraska to Detlef and Dorothea (Hanson) Schuett. Dorothy grew up in Bloomfield with her 9 brothers and sisters, and attended school there. She often told stories to her family about growing up during the Great Depression, and how hard things were for her family.

Dorothy married Donald Bayly in 1940 and to this union, two children were born: Jerry and Luann. The family lived in Waterloo, Nebraska throughout their married lives. Don preceded Dorothy in death in August of 1980.

Dorothy worked for a time in the kitchen at Haar's Restaurant and as a checker at Dick's IGA in Waterloo, but more than anything, she was a loving wife and mother. She will be remembered as a very good cook, a talented cake decorator, and as a woman who made her own candies that rivaled Russell Stover's! Dorothy took great pride in tending to her yard, and enjoyed riding the lawnmower. She also liked to crochet, making many baby blankets for the grandchildren and great grandchildren. Dorothy was also actively involved in breeding, training, and showing Toy Poodles, and was a member of the Companion Dog Club. It seemed she always had a new puppy to pass on to her kids or grandkids. Family was most important to Dorothy, and she was most proud of the accomplishments of her children, grandchildren, and great
