Dorothy Kathleen Stutzman, age 96 passed away peacefully on March 5, 2024 at the Burwell Community Memorial Health Center in Burwell, Nebraska. She was always up before the sun and if you wanted to spend time with Doc and Dorothy, you could count on them being in the corner booth at Lou's Diner at 8AM every Saturday, where Grandma always had her one egg and toast.
