



Dr. Monte Myrl Scott

August 23, 1932 - October 26, 2017

Dr. Monte Scott died Thursday, October 26, 2017 after a lengthy battle with Parkinson's Disease. He was born in Grand Island, Nebraska, the son of Walter and Mildred Scott. Dr. Scott graduated from Ravenna, Nebraska High School in 1950, and received his Baccalaureate in 1953, and his M.D. degree in 1957 from the University of Nebraska. He was a member of Sigma Xi, Phi Beta Kappa, AOA, and Phi Chi Medical fraternity. After receiving his M.D., he served ten years in the U.S. Army at hospitals in Denver, San Antonio, San Francisco, and Tacoma, achieving the rank of Major. Dr. Scott became a Fellow of the American College of Physicians in 1971. He was a life member and Chairman of the Task Force on AIDS in 1987, and was president of the Nebraska Society of Internal Medicine in 1982. After practicing Internal Medicine and Endocrinology at Platte Valley Medical Group in Kearney, Nebraska from 1965-69, he moved to Lincoln, Nebraska to help establish Wedgewood Medical Associates. He also was an instructor of Internal Medicine at UNMC from 1965-69, served on many boards, the most recent being the Tabitha Hospice Advisory Board, and consulted for the Nebraska Health and Human Services System.

He is survived by Marlys, his wife of nearly sixty-four years, three daughters; Dr. Kim Scott-Pozil (Dr. Larry), Ann Long (Dr. Douglas), and Jayne Hoffman (Dr. James). He leaves nine grandchildren; Eric (Tracy) and Scott (Rym) Pozil, Niki (Brandon) Deeds, Robyn (Kyle) Loos, Jake (Maggie) Long, Spencer

Long, and Jason, Tyler, and Keeva Hoffman, and six great grandchildren;
Sara, Annemarie, Charlotte, and Ryan Pozil, and Jace and Ryann Deeds.
