



Elmer Wilhelm Hallberg

May 19, 1911 - July 1, 2010

Elmer Wilhelm Hallberg was born on May 19, 1911 in Valley, Nebraska to Eric and Signe (Lagergren) Hallberg. He grew up in Valley where he attended District #35 grade school and Valley High School. As a young boy, Elmer enjoyed fishing, outdoor activities and spending time with his siblings and classmates. Elmer served his country during World War II from March of 1942 till December of 1945 in the United States Army Air Force.

Elmer married Lucille Jackson on August 18, 1944 in Spokane, Wyoming and they were blessed with three children: Harry, John and Karen. Elmer and Lucille raised their family in the rural Valley area.

Elmer has worked at an ice cream factory in Fremont, partnered in a trucking company, worked for Walter Hartford at Hartford Sand and Gravel and Valmont Industries. Elmer enjoyed hunting and fishing, traveling, camping and a leisurely drive in the country. He was a caring, gentle and frugal man. Elmer enjoyed family vacations and fly fishing in Wyoming. He liked cooking, playing cards and his coffee group at HyVee. Elmer loved to share his garden flowers. He took peonies, lilacs and surprise lilies to the banks in Valley and Elkhorn, and to the pharmacy and the city hall in Valley. He loved to share them and then returned several days later after the blooms had wilted to retrieve his vases to reuse. Elmer was a member of Valley American Legion Post #58 and St. Mark's Lutheran Church in Valley where he was baptized and confirmed on

December 18, 1955.

Elmer passed away on Thursday, July 1, 2010 at the Methodist Hospital in Omaha, Nebraska at the age of 99 years, 1 month and 12 days. He was preceded in death by his parents Eric and Signe; brothers Harry and Gust; sisters Ruth and Ann and his wife Lucille. Elmer is survived by his sons and daughter-in-law Harry of Ft. Walton Beach, Florida and John and Rose of Columbia, South Carolina; daughter and son-in-law Karen and Rob King of Valley, Nebraska; and 6 grandchildren and 8 great grandchildren.
