



Erma Emma Sievers

November 28, 1921 - May 1, 2008

Erma Emma (Mumm) Sievers was born on November 28, 1921 near Yutan, Nebraska to Henry and Anna Christina (Henningson) Mumm, the 2nd to last of eleven children. She grew up in Yutan where she attended District #66 country school and graduated from Yutan High School in 1939. Erma was baptized on May 27, 1923 and confirmed on May 10, 1936 at St. John's Lutheran Church. As a young girl, Erma spent much of her time helping to care for her large family.

Erma married Elmer Sievers on April 18, 1942 at the courthouse in Papillion, Nebraska and to this union four children were born: Jeris Ann, Glenn Edward, Sherlyn Rae and Kathleen Kay. Erma and Elmer raised their family in rural Yutan before moving into town in 1962.

Erma worked at Miller's Café, Stange Grocery Store, babysat and helped with the cooking and baking at Jeris' Café, but first and foremost she was a loving wife, mother and grandmother. She enjoyed gardening, cooking, baking, canning, embroidering and candle wicking. Erma took great joy in her grandchildren and was very proud of the success that her children and grandchildren accomplished. Special times consisted of holiday meals, summer picnics, grandchildren's activities and Mumm family reunions. Erma was a sincere, devoted, caring and loving woman who put others before herself. Erma was nicknamed the "Energizer Bunny", because even when she

became ill, she would bounce back and was ready to go again.

Erma passed away on Thursday, May 1, 2008 at the Lakeside Hospital in Omaha, Nebraska with her children at her side at the age of 86 years, 5 months and 3 days. She was preceded in death by her parents Henry and Christina, nine brothers and sisters and her husband Elmer. Erma is survived by her children and spouses Jeris and John Miller, Glenn and Linda Sievers, Sherlyn and Steven Hayes and Kathy and John Lewis all of Yutan, Nebraska; 11 grandchildren, 17 great grandchildren and 2 great great grandchildren; brother Glenn Mumm of Wahoo, Nebraska and sister-in-law Leatha Mumm of Yutan, Nebraska.
