Esteleen Frances Claussen Andresen was born on February 12, 1925 in Omaha, Nebraska to Reimer and Marie (Glandt) Claussen. She grew up on a farm near 156th and Dodge St., attended grade school at a country school near 156th and Maple St. and graduated from Benson High School in 1942. As a young girl, Esteleen enjoyed baseball, riding her pony and helping on the farm.

Esteleen married Vern Andresen on May 19, 1951 at the Bethany Lutheran Church in Elkhorn, Nebraska and to this union a daughter, Diane, was born. Esteleen and Vern lived on two farms north of Valley and after Vern's death Esteleen moved to Valley.

Esteleen was an active farm wife, raising chickens and making butter and cottage cheese that she sold to the local families. Throughout her life she enjoyed her pets and took great pride in her gardening. She is remembered as a strong woman with a quick smile and a happy demeanor.

Esteleen passed away at her home in Valley, Nebraska with her family by her side at the age of 83 years, 8 months and 23 days.
