Eugenio Arturo was born and raised in Mexico City, Mexico. His father was from Germany and his mother from Mexico. He grew up with German influence and attended a German school where athletics were instilled early on. In his younger years, he played college basketball and “American Football” at the University of Mexico. Many years ago, he was inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame in Mexico. The combination of these sports gave him the skills to play handball for the Mexican Olympic Team. For many years growing up, sports were a big part of his life. One of his favorite sayings was “healthy mind in healthy body” and he wrote a book to inspire young athletes. His passion was to talk about the sports he participated in and the great victories he had. His life revolved around sports, and his daughter continued this by becoming an Olympic level swimmer. He was an adventurous spirit who loved to climb mountains and experience the outdoors.

His wife was his partner for over sixty years. He was very grateful for her. Arturo and his wife (Lulu) moved to Nebraska a few years ago to be with their children and their families. He was very proud of his children. His grandchildren were the biggest joy in his life, and he enjoyed watching and cheering them on. Before retiring, they were both dentists. He practiced dentistry for over four decades and was one of the first pioneers for dental implants in Mexico. They have a daughter, two sons and six grandchildren. He spoke Spanish, English and German.
