“ Georgia- go girl go

*Many may not have thought of how athletic Georgia was? She figured out a long time ago she was in a race that only the Lord could have her run. She also was in the grand stands down here rooting on, those of us, running the race the Lord has us running until we finish across the finish line ourselves. Georgia and I talked freely and excitedly many times about the possibility of being taken up together by the Lord, which we knew, it could happen any time now. Well she&#226;€™s out in front of us and you go girl go, and it was fair because the Lord had His reasons and made it so. It is hard for those closest to her she left behind, but I encourage them mount up on the wings of eagles, as the Lord Himself will lift you up, just keep looking up. The same strength that Georgia found is = Eph 6:10 Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might.*

*The following is the evidence the Apostile Paul was a sports enthusiast as he compares the race Georgia and we run, like to the Olympics.*

*1Co 9:24 Know ye not that they which run in a race run all, but one receiveth the prize? So run, that ye may obtain.*

*25 And every man that striveth for the mastery is temperate in all things. Now they do it to obtain a corruptible crown; but we an incorruptible.*

*26 I therefore so run, not as uncertainly; so fight I, not as one that beateth the air: (We are to run certain for a goal and not run in vain)*

*27 But I keep under my body, and bring it into subjection: lest that by any means, when I have preached to others, I myself should be a castaway. (Georgia had received the power over her body and kept focused on the Lord and she has won.) 1Co 15:55 O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory? Against all odds she rested in the Lord and the power in the blood of Jesus has carried her through.*

*Heb 12:1 Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race*

*that is set before us, (As we run for the Lord, we are to pace ourselves and if we need to sprint He will let us know or intercede for us, but keep a sharp eye, the goal is in sight.)*

*Heb 12:2 Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God. (Jesus is always interceding for His own) Georgia also like I had come to understand that the Lord crosses denominational boundaries and when we come together that those that are His that trust in the finished work he did on the cross 2,000 years ago, will not have denominational pins once in heaven.*

*The following illustrates how cancer did not win, but became defeated along with Satan.*

*2 Cor 5:1 ¶;¶; For we know that if our earthly house of this tabernacle were dissolved(our present bodies), we have a building of God, an house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens (in others words we will receive a new body).*

*2 For in this we groan, earnestly desiring to be clothed upon with our house (or new body) which is from heaven:*

*3 If so be that being clothed (in righteousness of Christ) we shall not be found naked. (Refer to Matt 22: 11 And when the king came in to see the guests, he saw there a man which had not on a wedding garment: 22:12 And he saith unto him, Friend, how camest thou in hither not having a wedding garment? And he was speechless.)*

*Georgia will have her wedding garment on at the wedding to come in heaven as part of the Church. The wedding garment represents those things she obeyed the Lord on down here as she sowed to the Spirit, not to the flesh.*

*4 For we that are in this tabernacle (this old body) do groan, being burdened: not for that we would be unclothed (our unrighteous deeds), but clothed upon(righteousness of Christ), that mortality might be swallowed up of life.*

*5 Now he that hath wrought us for the selfsame thing is God, who*

*also hath given unto us the earnest of the Spirit. (This is the earnest deposit like one would put a down payment on a house, but as a believer this is the down payment of the Holy Spirit, the Lord himself places on all believers, so as in Joh 10:28 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand. Joh 10:29 My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand). Georgia was and is His.*

*6 Therefore we are always confident, knowing that, whilst we are at home in the body (which is this present body), we are absent from the Lord:*

*7 (For we walk by faith, not by sight:)*

*8 We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.*

*9 Wherefore we labour, that, whether present or absent, we may be accepted of him.*

*10 For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things done in his (or her) body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad. (Georgia sowed to the Spirit and had accomplished His will, so much will He grant to her, while things she may have sowed to the flesh, His blood has cleansed and made her white, for the wedding of the Bride Groom)*

*Now the question is will we follow her lead, which was His lead and finish the course He has laid for each of us, and grab hold of knowing we have a position in Him and trust Him.*
