Gregory G. Ammon was born December 13, 1968, in Farmington, Minnesota to Melvin and Evelyn (Meyer) Ammon. Greg grew up in Lakeville, MN where he attended Orchard Lake Elementary School, and graduated from Lakeville High School in 1987. Following high school, Greg earned his Bachelor of Science degree in Chemical Engineering from the University of North Dakota in December 1991. Growing up, Greg enjoyed fishing, snowmobiling, and playing baseball.

Greg married Jana Von Feldt on April 19, 2008, at Trinity Evangelical Free Church in Lakeville, MN and to this union, two daughters were born, Jessica Jean and Natalie Lynn. The family made their home in Omaha, Nebraska. Greg and Jana went to high school together and were friends, but it wasn't until 20 years later at a reunion that they started dating. They were married 8 months later!

Greg worked as a chemical engineer for many years, working as a Director in the Environmental Group at Northern Natural Gas. When he wasn't working, Greg enjoyed fishing and pheasant hunting, but his favorite time was spent either at the soccer fields watching the girls play, or time at their lake in Emmetsburg, Iowa, especially if his "best buddy" Chip was by his side (the family dog).

Greg was a hardworking, inquisitive, determined, faithful and loyal man. As a Vikings fan, his favorite color was purple, and he also cheered on the Minnesota Twins. His favorite band was The Offspring, and favorite movie,

“Guardians of the Galaxy”. He was happy with a night out for sushi or dinner at Red Robin, and a gin and tonic.
