February 11, 1915 - August 24, 2007

Helen Lorraine (Compton) Moore was born on February 11, 1915 in Waterloo, Nebraska to Arthur Dayton and Esther Mary (McWhorter) Compton. She grew up on the family farm south of Waterloo and attended Country School #14 before graduating from Waterloo High School in 1931. She went on to receive her teaching certificate from Midlands College. As a young girl, Lorraine enjoyed ice skating, dancing, shopping, swimming and horseback riding.

Lorraine married Marvin Moore on August 24, 1940 in Omaha, Nebraska and to this union two sons were born: Thomas and Jerry. Lorraine and Marvin raised their family in the Waterloo area.

Lorraine taught in a rural school near Gretna, Nebraska before transferring to the Waterloo Public School and finishing the final 27 years of her career in Waterloo. She went back to school and in 1973 received her teaching degree. Lorraine still enjoyed shopping, dancing and just gadding about. She was active in Peace Presbyterian Church especially the pantry, Delta Kappa Gamma and Red Hats. Lorraine was honored twice as the Waterloo Citizen of the Year. Lorraine is remembered as an independent woman who treasured her family and 'live life on her own terms'.

Lorraine passed away on Friday, August 24, 2007 at the Methodist Hospital in Omaha, Nebraska at the age of 92 years, 6 months and 13 days. She was

preceded in death by her parents Arthur and Esther, husband Marvin and sisters Gladys Compton and Leora Arp. Lorraine is survived by sons and daughters-in-law Tom and Anita of Holt, MO and Jerry and Linda of Waterloo, NE. grandchildren Kimberlee and Eric Krawchuk of Kansas City, MO and Scott and Meg Moore of Overland Park, KS.
