Even though he didn't have very many words, the looks on his face told you everything. His favorite things in the world were to snuggle his Uh, oh pooh bear, walk, sit in the front window and watch whatever was happening outside and being outside just sitting with you. He also loved his grandma singing Jesus loves you and his grandpa's bath time. He let his brother and sisters climb on him and he had a special look, smile or laugh for every family member. He said thank you and love you so sweetly that it almost felt like you didn't deserve such gratitude
