She grew up on a farm near Wood River where she attended grade school and graduated from Wood River High School in 1967. As a young girl, Jacquie was active in all aspects of farm life including cooking, sewing and 4-H. She was a cheerleader, a great student and an a dedicated participant in Jobe's Daughters. Following high school, Jacquie studied education receiving her Bachelor's Degree from "Kearney State" and a Master's Degree from Doane College.

Jacquie married David Jacox on December 20, 1969 at the Methodist Church in Grand Island, Nebraska. Dave and Jacquie were 20 years old when they said "I do" and have been madly in love ever since. These two crazy kids were known as "night owls", always on the move going out with friends and enjoying life.
