James Teddy "Ted" Fowler was born on July 2, 1941 in Oklahoma City to Clare and Ollie (Boyd) Fowler. His family moved to Palmdale, California when Ted was five. Ted attended Antelope Valley High School, graduating in 1957. After high school, Ted joined the Marine Corps, where he served until 1963 when he was honorably discharged.

During high school, Ted was a part of the Jesters Car Club. Fortunately, one of the members lived next to Jean Martin, and the Jesters spent a lot of time there. Mutual friends set up Ted and Jean and the two were married on June 30, 1962. They were blessed with three children: James Clare in 1962, Andrea in 1966 and Melissa in 1969. Sadly, James Clare passed away at 14 months due to a heart condition.

Ted and Jean raised their family in California and eventually settled in the small town of Tehachapi. In 2022, they moved to Nebraska. Ted worked for many years in auto sales, and he also owned various businesses throughout his life including an Oldsmobile General Motors dealership, a feedstore, and a hair salon. In his free time, Ted enjoyed riding dirt bikes, camping, and loved horses and mules. He spent time as the president of the Chamber of Commerce in Tehachapi and through that became involved in helping with the setup of the PRCA Rodeo, which he greatly enjoyed. He was also a big fan of NASCAR; his favorite driver was Kevin Harvick. Ted also liked to listen to

country music, and his favorite foods were prime rib, filet mignon, and Fowler Family Tacos.

Ted always had a salesman personality; he loved people and was outgoing, kind, and fun to be around. He knew a joke for every occasion, and if he didn't have one ready, he would make one up. He brightened up the days of the staff and other residents at Valley Lakes; Ted and Jean were just unanimously voted Valentine's King and Queen. He was also very family oriented, and he adored his grandchildren and great grandchildren.

Ted passed away at the age of 83 at his home in Valley, NE. He was preceded in death by his parents, Clare and Ollie Fowler; son, James Clare; daughter, Melissa Halasey; and siblings: Helen, Buster, and Donna. He is survived by his wife of 62 years, Jean Fowler; daughter, Andrea Hansen (Peder); grandchildren: Kayla Bradley (DJ), Riley Halasey, Madison Halasey, and William Teddy Hansen; great grandchildren, Lucy and Olivia Bradley; siblings: Robbie Nelson, JoAnn Blair, and Ervine Fowler (Linda); and many nieces, nephews, and extended family members.

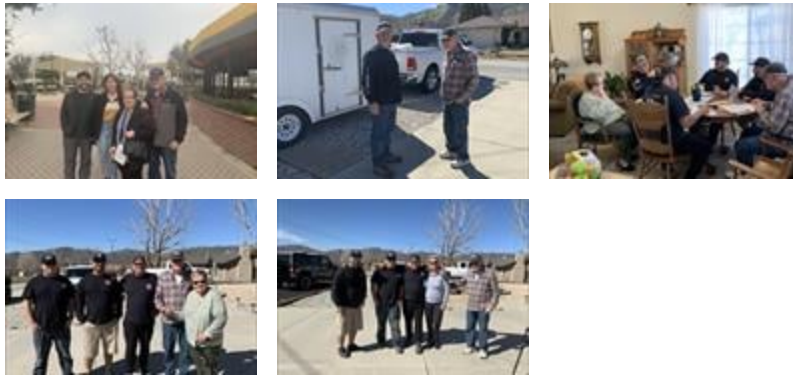
