Jason's paternal grandparents resided in Florida and the family visited often. He was a beach baby. He loved the Gulf of Mexico and would always scare his parents by venturing too far out. Snorkeling was his favorite pastime in Florida.

Jason was a Boy Scout, which he loved, and learned many skills throughout the years in the scouts. He achieved his Eagle Scout which he was very proud of.

Jason grew up playing soccer, baseball, wrestling and football. But his passion was racing. When he was younger, he was a part of a pit crew at a local racetrack and truly loved it. He continued to follow racing all of his adult life and current favorite driver was Joey Logano.

The scouts aided Jason in the next step in his life which was the military. He joined the Army National Guard in 1999 and served until his death. Jason was an aircraft mechanic and flying became another one of his passions. He served two deployments, the first a peace-keeping mission in Bosnia in 2003 and Afghanistan later in his career. Jason and his team were an integral part of the search and rescue efforts after the flood of 2019.

Jason had lots of family he loved to spend time with. He especially enjoyed teasing his nieces and nephews. His best friend was Archie, his dog, who was found at a rest stop, abandoned. Archie was lucky to have Jason.

Jason was kind, had a wonderful sense of humor, and would do anything for you. We will truly miss our sweet boy.

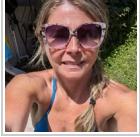
