When all her kids had grown, Jean decided it was time to expand her life and moved to Seattle WA, relocating her job to the Seattle office in 1994. Jean then met Gary Coard and she would retire early and started her new adventure of living on boats and traveling the world. Her first was 'Ghost Fox', a sailboat and then Gary and Jean bought their beloved Krogen 'Daisy' where they started many years of boating around the East coast, making friends everywhere they went. Jean has always been the social butterfly, and she had

many new boating friends she would cherish. Jean and Gary were married on Daisy on November 28, 1998.
