Joseph M. “Joe” Arkfeld was born June 21, 1956 in Harlan, Iowa to Clarence and Anna Marie (Schmieding) Arkfeld. Joe grew up in Defiance, Iowa and graduated from Harlan High School in 1974.

Joe married Mary Lisko on September 5, 1987 at St. Robert Bellarmine Catholic Church in Omaha, Nebraska. He was the proud father of Melissa, Kelsey, and Trisha. The family made their home in Omaha before moving to Mallard Landing in Valley, Nebraska.
