Keith Edward Ramsey was born on November 6, 1938 in Barada, Nebraska to Jack and Eula (Sailors) Ramsey. He grew up in Shubert, NE attending grade school in Rual District 18. Growing up, he enjoyed hunting, fishing, horse riding, working on cars, and playing football. In 1956, Keith graduated from North High School in Omaha, NE.

On August 13, 1957 Keith was united in marriage to Marilyn Merz in Hiawatha, Kansas. Beginning in 1957, Keith served in the United States Marine Corps for two years, earning a Good Conduct Medal before his honorable discharge in 1959.
