Kim Marie Koenig, age 69, passed away unexpectedly on August 2, 2025, in Omaha, Nebraska. Born on March 13, 1956, in Appleton, Wisconsin, Kim's vibrant spirit, warm heart, and unwavering loyalty to her roots left a lasting impression on everyone who knew her.

Kim was the beloved daughter of Bruce and Mae Miller. She earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Marketing and Office Management from Northern Michigan University. Kim's greatest joy was her family, and she was a proud and devoted grandmother to her three grandsons and one granddaughter. She is also survived by her sister Connie and brother Todd.

A funeral service will be held on August 12, 2025, with family visitation beginning at 10:00 a.m., followed by a Celebration of Life Service. Guests are invited to join the family for a luncheon at the funeral home after the service.
