“ Dear Sea Turtle Conservation League Volunteers,

It is with a heavy heart that I write to you. Our dear sea turtle friend, Kristin Larson, unexpectedly passed away on January 1, 2024 on her way home from visiting her family for two weeks over the Christmas holiday.

Kristin started with us in 2007, the first biologist to volunteer with the Sea Turtle Conservation League of Singer Island. At that time, our survey area began at Ocean Mall's south border and ended at Mac Arthur Beach State Parks southern border. Kristin was 39 years old at this time.

I was thrilled to have such a delightful, smart, sensitive person in our turtle group. Kristin worked for the South Florida Water Management District during the week. She arranged her schedule to have Friday's off, which for the past 16 years, was always her day to do the nesting survey. Everyone who worked with Kristin loved her! And I was thankful to have her lead the team with her knowledge of our program on Singer Island. I can't begin to figure out the number of hatchlings Kristin saved during her 16 years working on a very heavily nested beach.

Kristin was a huge animal rescue advocate. She was always fostering dogs and cats and would take home the sickest of them, in order to nurse them back to health. She always had transport cages in the backseat of her car, to head out with the most recently rescued animal. I loved hearing about what she was up to each week in her endeavors.

Many of you didn't know that Kristin was also a volunteer for the Kravis Center, where she ushered on Wed. nights. She had a lot of enjoyment from this program, which enabled her to see some of the best shows in Palm Beach County.

Kristin was a marathon swimmer. Many of you remember some of

the meets she would swim, that were long and hard in the ocean. I was always in awe of her strength to do this. She always finished each swim and would get ready for the next event in the future.

About 9 years ago, Kristin fought Ovarian cancer and had Chemo. Her health looked good after this. Unknown to me, she was scheduled for surgery on January 22nd to remove a mass that had grown. Her sister, Erin told me she was not one to let everyone know what she was going through, health-wise.

She wanted people to treat her normally. What courage she displayed!

I am so glad that she was at my house on December 2nd, for our annual Volunteer Appreciation Dinner, because that was probably the last time any of us would see her. She was happy and looking forward to seeing her family over the holidays. She discussed the 2024 nesting season with one of her partners from Friday, Cara Abbott, and about being together again with Erica Oshier, starting on March 1st, 2024.

“ Kristin was my first cousin and the closest thing to a sister I've known. We grew up sharing an intense (pathological) love of animals and obsession with our Breyer model horses, all of which were entitled with both formal and practical names (e.g., Charging for Leadership a.k.a Charger for the rearing bay stallion). We probably had at least 30-40 models each and all of their names and pedigrees (made up) were carefully documented on sheets of notebook paper in Kristin's recognizable script. Anyone who knew her would be familiar with her penmanship as she was diligent to remember every birthday or occasion with a kind (snail mail) card and anecdote. We shared a desire and plan to become veterinarians, but early on she realized she was too kind hearted and empathetic to perform some of the job's mandates. Instead she found her passion in animal rescue. All who knew her well experienced the unforeseen consequences of her dedication: detours that took you far off course to pick up or transfer a homeless pet, long lonely waits on curbs or in restaurants-or worse, nail biters for airport transports - finding out later she had snuck some animal related task into the already tight itinerary, approving your personal cell phone (she refused to have one of her own) for animal rescue related calls and texts throughout a vacation and surprise "volunteer" activities that you found yourself a participant in. Kristin was kind and sensitive, stubborn and impossibility strong (even in her last days she could wrestle her burly foster dog to submission). She loved her family and friends and she fought for the weak and underserved. She was a fierce environmentalist who lead beach cleanups and preferred a night in a tent to a 5 star hotel. She was gentle and kind and made an impact on all that knew her. I wish there were more days, and I hope that she knew how much we all loved her.

“ Kristin was one of those special people that gives more of herself than she ever got back. She started as a co-worker and we became good friends. When she was in the hospital with the first bout of cancer we visited her and when I was in the hospital she would come, bringing books (always about dogs since she knew I loved dogs) and sitting there telling me amusing stories and about different movies.

As most know she was not the greatest with technology. We spent some time getting her iPad (gifted from a sister because she would never think to buy one) so she could get emails for work. I would help her at work with the technology but she was the greatest in the field and working with our landowners. They loved her gentle nature. She always had a bag and we would be out in the field she would pick up trash. She treated everyone she met with dignity and respect regardless of who they were. She would be pulling out invasive vegetation to give the native vegetation a chance. One of the pictures posted here is her bent over doing that.

I knew she was sick and kept after her to go to the Drs. She lost weight quickly. But while her passing shocked me, it really shocked others. Kristin did not want to bother other's or bring them down with her problems. But she was a great listener, a sounding board for others problems.

Kristin hated cell phones and refused to carry one. When her van broke down she would walk the 3 or so miles to get to Publix. They would let her use their phone and she would call to see if it would be too much trouble to get her or she would walk the 8 or so miles home. The old rescue van broke down frequently.

Kristin was a gentle soul. She was my friend and I loved her. She was loved by many. She will be missed.

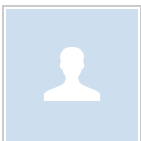
