



## Kyle Thomas Duckert

May 19, 1988 - December 21, 2013

Kyle Thomas Duckert was born on May 19, 1988 in Milwaukee, Wisconsin to Randy and Jamie (Hildebrand) Duckert. He grew up in Salt Lake City, Utah and Fargo, North Dakota before the family settled in Omaha, where he attended grade school and graduated from Millard West High School in 2006. Kyle attended Loyola University in Chicago, Illinois where he received his 3 Bachelor's degrees in Math, Physics, and Applied Mathematics. He also received his Master's Degree in Math there. As a young boy, Kyle enjoyed fishing, making music, swimming and lacrosse, and life at the Duckert house. He was a very talented musician, playing multiple instruments and singing in the choir. He was also known to throw the best parties, often very large and with live bands. While in Chicago, Kyle volunteered to teach at inner city schools and provided additional tutoring. In his natural spirit of giving, Kyle purchased a computer for one of his exceptional students who could not afford one.

Kyle was a brilliant and talented man who loved to share and teach. In Omaha, Kyle was a physics and math Instructor at UNO. He continued his love of music, playing in the church band and singing in the choir. He loved the outdoors, especially fishing and was a wonderful gourmet cook. Kyle was passionate about learning. He was kind and loving, always helpful and rooting for the underdog.

Kyle passed away on December 21, 2013 at his home in Omaha at the age of 25 years, 7 months and 2 days. He was preceded in death by his grandparents Patricia Hildebrand and Chester Duckert. Great grandparents Jeanette and William Dean and Victor and Martha Hildebrand and Aunt Jennifer Hildebrand.
