Larry Melvin Seefus was born on July 3, 1937 in Valley, Nebraska, to Raymond and Iola (Clark) Seefus. Larry graduated from Valley High School in 1954, and then went on to graduate from the Commercial Extension School of Commerce in Omaha, Nebraska.

After selling his business, Larry worked at First Data before retiring in 2001.
