Leland Bunz was born in Bennington, NE on December 17, 1933. He attended Bennington High School and after the family moved to Elkhorn he graduated from Elkhorn High School. After high school Lee farmed with his father and brother, but decided to get a job in town and became a mechanic for Witte Implements in Bennington in 1953. Eventually Lee bought the John Deere dealership from Chet Witte in 1969 and renamed it Bunz Implement. In 1977 he moved the business from downtown Bennington to a much larger facility on highway 36 and 156th street. He owned the business for 23 years until his retirement.

Lee was active in Bennington community as a member of the Lions Club, sponsoring Legion baseball teams and actively supporting St. John's Church and owning his business for 23 years until his retirement.

Lee met his wife Kathy in Omaha, and they were married in 1970. They were married for 46 years and enjoyed traveling the world together. Trips with John Deere included Australia, Hong Kong, and Hawaii were among his favorite. Lee was also an avid bowler and took many trips with his bowling team to tournaments around the country.

Lee loved sports, especially Nebraska and St. Louis Cardinal baseball. He took many trips to see the Cardinals with his son Scott and his grand children

Jake and Joe. He also attended many of his grandsons sporting events and enjoyed talking about them with his friends

He is preceded in death by his parents Harold and Anne, brother Gene Bunz, and wife Kathy Bunz. He is survived by his son Scott Bunz (Danielle), grandchildren Jake Bunz and Joe Bunz, brother in law and sister in law Mark and Susie Hinton, nephew Matt Hinton and niece, Laura Gochenour and his special friend Darlene Hazard.
