



Leslie Farnam Honeycutt

October 29, 1944 - March 22, 2022

Leslie June Farnam Honeycutt was born on October 29, 1944, in Omaha, Nebraska to Lester and Juanita (Nita) Farnam. She grew up in Valley, NE where she attended elementary and high school. Growing up, Leslie was involved in Girl Scouts, helping her mom at Les & Nita's Beauty Salon and spending many summers at her grandparent's farm in Tekamah.

Leslie's work life started at Western Electric in the late 60's, then in 1971 she started at Kellogg's and was there until she retired, September 2001. She loved camping at Two Rivers; started with a tent then moved on to a pop-up. In the 80's she bought a trailer and moved it onto family grounds along the banks of the Missouri River. After her mom passed away in 2016, Leslie moved into the red brick house up at the river and stayed there until October 2021 when the complications from ALS required she move in with her daughter, Monica.

Leslie loved being 'up at the river' and spent her time gardening, tending to her martin house and bluebird houses, feeding hummingbirds and Orioles, socializing with her neighbors and watching the river flow by. She also was an active member of Bluebirds Across Nebraska.

Leslie passed away on Tuesday, March 22, 2022, in Omaha at the age of 77. She was preceded in death by her parents, Lester and Nita Farnam, husband Harold "Butch" Honeycutt, and grandson Nathan Waggoner. Leslie is survived by daughters Monica Waggoner of Omaha, Melanie (David) Edward of Los Angeles, CA, Shana (Tim) Hester of Elkhorn, Haley Cortez of Valley; 9 grandchildren Nicholas, Rachel, Tanner, Carley, Quintin, Skylar, Kalynn, Jayden, Cooper; 2 great-grandchildren Lincoln and Margaret; sisters Annette (Mike) Barauskas, of Fremont and Lynnell (Tom) Rowe, of Omaha.
